Abstracts are to be submitted in English as a Microsoft Word Document. Please do not insert graphs, tables and illustrations. Abstract will not be reviewed if the word count exceeds 300.

Abstracts should include:

1. The Title should be brief and typed in capitals
2. A statement of objectives of the study
3. A description of the methods used
4. A summary of the results obtained
5. A statement of the conclusions reached

Individuals requiring official letter of Invitation can request one from the Secretariat. Delegates must register to the Congress and submit payment in full.

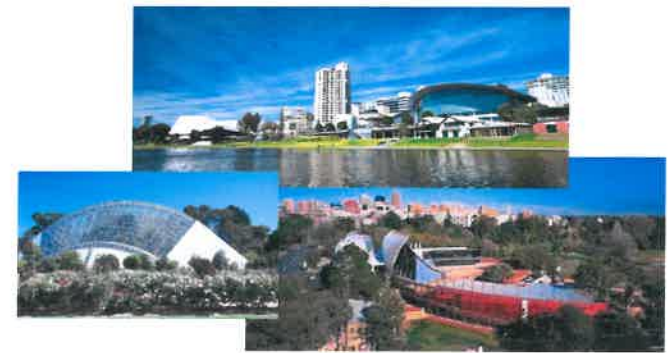

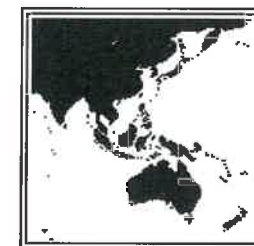
